SERVICE STRUCTURE



- Arrive early and set the room up
- Put out literature
- Welcome someone who walks in the room
- After a meeting suggest literature
- Share phone and meeting list
- Share inspiration line and 24/7 numbers
- Suggest fellowship after a meeting

DO YOU REMEMBER YOUR FIRST MEETING?



S.L.A.A. Meetings - Weekly phone, web and in person meetings where those who identify as a sex and love addict attend and share their hope and experiences.

Intergroups - Often held once a month and find ways to help the meetings. Some ways are by holding retreats, events, creating literature & fliers for upcoming events and maintaining a web site for S.L.A.A. information.

Service Committees - Often meet monthly by phone to provide a more thorough look into many areas of the fellowship. For example some committees available are: Journal, Sponsorship, Literature, Healthy Relationships, Anorexia, Finance and include more than a dozen areas of the fellowship.

F.W.S (Fellowship Wide Services) - Consists of the fellowship as a whole, and has a direct link to all meetings, intergroups and committees. F.W.S. is overseen by a 9-member board of trustees (B.O.T). F.W.S is responsible for performing duties and legal requirements and to help S.L.A.A. as a whole achieve its primary purpose — to carry the message to the sex and love addict who still suffers. F.W.S. is responsible for assisting the annual business conference and oversees the conference committees with the B.O.T.
